HR Consulting Firm Submitted their Report

After completing all the activities, the HR Firm submitted their report to ICAB President NKA Mobin FCA on 16 March 2026.

Between January and March 2026, the consulting firm Enroute International Limited (a renowned HR firm) conducted a comprehensive assessment covering the institutional organogram, role diagnostics, job descriptions, KPI framework, job evaluation methodology, performance appraisal system, and employee realignment framework. Based on the review, a revised organogram and a structured performance management system were developed to align ICAB's operations with its strategic priorities.

Within the month of January, February and March for the year 2026, the HR Firm worked in the following areas:

- 1. Organogram:** After reviewing the existing organogram and the organizational structure of ICAB, HR firm suggested a new Organogram for ICAB. The Office Bearers of ICAB and a dedicated committee also worked on it.
- 2. Role Diagnostic Assessment:** The findings from this diagnostic exercise conducted by Enroute formed the foundation for developing standardized Job Descriptions (JDs) and SMART KPIs for all of the officials of ICAB.
- 3. Job Descriptions & SMART KPI Framework:** Standardized Job Descriptions (JD) and KPI derived from the role profiling.



- 4. Job Evaluation Methodology:** Two-Step Hybrid Point-Factor Job Evaluation Method based on Hay/IPE logic, customized for ICAB's institutional context.
- 5. Performance Appraisal System:** A standard performance appraisal system has been initiated and developed for the officials of ICAB which is related to the KPI & Performance Appraisal System.
- 6. Employee Realignment Framework:** It provides clear visibility of employee positioning and supports timely management decisions, while identifying high-value roles with low performance and lower-value roles with strong performance for appropriate placement actions.
- 7. Job Evaluation & Role Stabilization Framework:** Based on the Job Role Score, a Grade Stabilization Framework is developed across three Position Structural Zones.

ICAB Academic Campus News

The session (Dec'25-Feb'26, 25th Batch) for Certificate Level students which was started from 28-Dec-2025, already concluded on 08-Mar-2026 (keeping some special arrangements on Friday & Saturday). There were 1,153 students joining with 56 teachers for the session. Here all students are the fresh candidates for the Certificate Level exam, Session: May 2026 (1st Quarter), to be held from 02-May-2026. By the way, another new batch of Certificate Level students has been started from 10-Mar-2026.

The session of Professional Level (22th Batch, Students-573, Teachers-28) which was begun from 10-Feb-2025, will now be closed by 06-May-2026. Here all students are going to be appeared at the exam, as examines for the Session: May 2026 (1st Quarter), to be held from 11-May-2026.

On the other hand, the classes of Advanced Level have been started from 16-Feb-2026 (19th Batch, Students-160, Teachers-10), and the session will be closed by 08-May-2026.

The Class Management Department is ready with its preparation for organizing all the courses (regular, flexible & special classes of Professional & Advanced Levels physically at academic venues, CA Bhaban, 1st floor & 4th floor; and Certificate Level sessions through online system) all over the year, as instructed by the Board of Studies (BoS) of the Institute for the benefit of the students. The concerned students are joining there happily and completing all the classes effectively.

In the meantime, the Articleship Management Department has been registered articled students 135 and 37 of PAS (pre-articled students) within the month of March 2026. The "Knowledge Sharing Session (KSS)" for Newly Registered Students (53th

Batch) already organized in the month of March 29, 30 & 31, 2026.

Furthermore, the Study Materials Department and ICAB-Central Library are utilizing services keeping with upgradation as maintained by the directives of government and also decisions of ICAB management time to time through on line and offline systems. Study manuals & books are now available at Books' Sale Centre. Students are coming attractively there, and users receiving dedicated services from the library, too.

The Students' Counseling and Placement Department (SCPD) has already planned to hold a-Student Awareness and Motivational Programs titled "Start Chartered Accountancy, When You Study in College/University with the 4-Departments' of Govt. B M College, Barishal, after 3rd week of April, 2026. Furthermore, Pre-Articled Students (PAS) program communication with the different universities, colleges and English medium schools are running, and registration is open for all the concerned students. By the way, Exemption/ Waiver related addendum on earlier Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signing ceremony is going to be opened with the different universities and ICAB, after the 2nd week of April 2026. This department also intends to meet and share academic views with the International University of Business Agriculture and Technology (IUBAT), Uttara Model Town, Dhaka within the 4th week of April 2026.

Report on Disciplinary Actions

The Council-ICAB has taken disciplinary actions against some of its members on 07 April 2026 based on the recommendations of the Investigation & Disciplinary Committee (IDC). The summary of those disciplinary actions are as follows:

Name of the Member: Mr. S. M. Rafiqul Islam FCA (867), Senior Partner at S M Rafique & Co., Chartered Accountants

Disciplinary Actions:

The Council of ICAB decided to suspend Mr. S. M. Rafiqul Islam FCA (867), partner of S M Rafique & Co., Chartered Accountants from practice as a public accountant for providing ONLY statutory audit service for a period of nine months together with an imposition of monetary penalty of Tk. 200,000 (Taka two lakh). The penalty of restrictions on access to

DVC generation shall take effect retrospectively from the 30th July 2025. If the monetary penalty is not paid by the 30th April 2026, his suspension from practice as a public accountant for providing ONLY statutory audit service shall further continue for an additional period of six months starting from the expiration of the first mentioned suspension period.

Name of the Member: Mr. Tarafder Jahangir Alam FCA (1013), Partner at Chowdhury Hossain Rashid & Co. Chartered Accountants

Disciplinary Actions:

The Council-ICAB decided to suspend Mr. Tarafder Jahangir Alam FCA (1013), partner of Chowdhury Hossain Rashid & Co. Chartered Accountants from practice as a public accountant for providing ONLY statutory audit service for a period of 01 (one) year together with an

imposition of monetary penalty of Tk. 500,000 (Taka five lakh). The penalty of restrictions on access to DVC generation shall take effect retrospectively from the 30th July 2025. If the monetary penalty is not paid within three (03) months from the date of communication of the Council decision, his suspension from practice as a public accountant for providing ONLY statutory audit service shall remain suspended for an additional one year period starting from the expiration of the first mentioned suspension period.
